What We'll Never Do

- We will never email you new banking details at the last minute. If you receive a message claiming we've changed our account information, call your Nelligan Law lawyer directly to confirm.
- We do not pressure clients into urgent wire transfers or payments. We'll always explain what you're paying for, and give you time to ask questions.
- We will never ask you to send money to third-party or offshore accounts without prior discussion and documentation.

How to Verify You're Communicating with Us

- Our emails always end in @nelliganlaw.ca. Watch for fake domains like "nelliganlaw.ca" (note two Vs instead of a "w") or added dashes/spaces.
- If you receive a suspicious email or message, call us using the phone number on our website: nelliganlaw.ca.
- Always double-check email spelling, tone, and context. If something seems "off," trust your instincts and verify.
- We'll never ask you to send sensitive documents (like ID or banking info) via text message.

Extra Caution for Real Estate Transactions

- Real estate fraud is on the rise. Here's how to stay safe:
 - Always verify bank account details by calling your Nelligan Law lawyer directly before sending large payments.
 - Avoid making payments based on instructions sent via email alone.
 - Be wary of emails that create a sense of urgency around closing dates or payment deadlines.
